

# Welcome to the new Everyrace.com

Everyrace.com has a new look, new functionality, and new products. To help with this change, we have created this getting started guide that describes what's changed in buying the Wizard, some new features of the web site and our new product Wizard Plus.

## What's Changed in Buying the Wizard

The first thing you will need to do is log in. The link to log into the web site is now at the top right of all pages. Even if you used the "remember my details on this computer" on the old site, you will need to log in to the new site. **Please make sure you know your password, contact us if you are not sure.**

The new site also has a "Remember Me" option to log you in automatically and a forgot my password option to have a new password emailed to you.

## Buying the Wizard

Two big changes for buying the wizard. Firstly, no PIN! Second, you select the day you wish to purchase, rather than individual files. Once you have purchased the Wizard for the day, you will be taken to a web page with links to all available files for that day.

Downloading the Wizard with scratchings or downloading files again doesn't require you to go through the purchase process again. The site knows what you have paid for, and provides links to all files for the days purchased.

## No Ratings Wizards

The new web site has Wizard files for an extra day in advance. These files are called the "No Ratings" wizard and have all the normal information contained in the Wizard prints, but no ratings, assessed odds, panel or comment. The fully featured Wizard files will still be available the afternoon before the meeting.

## Adding money to your account

This works similar to the existing site; either select "Pay Account" from the account menu or click on your name at the top left of any page to go to your account page, and then click the "Pay Account" button.

Credit card details are processed in the background on our website. There is no longer a jump to the NAB web site for payments. Also, we only hold your credit card information for the duration of the transaction. No financial details (Credit Card number, etc) are stored on our web site.

## Security

The new site use SSL. You will no longer receive any warnings about the site being insecure.

## Wizard Rewards

Wizard rewards continue to operate, but we have removed Quickform as a reward. It is now one of the files you get when you buy the Wizard for a day.

## Wizard Reports

We have retired the Wizard Reports (Quickform, Proform and Ratings Plus) as separate products. Quickform is now part of the files available for purchasing the Wizard. Proform and Ratings Plus are part of our new offering, Wizard Plus.

## New Features of the Web site

We hope the improvements we have made to the current way of purchasing the Wizard will make it easier and simpler for you to get what you are after from the site.

### The Home Page

- The first new thing you notice about the new site is the Wizard Race Fields on the home page.
- More information is on the home page to better help you use the features of everyrace.com. If you use Wizard systems, the results are shown on the home page.
- A purchased content section at the top right of the home page. This will have links to everything you have purchased, helping you get what you are after faster.
- Search facility to find horse, trainer, or jockey.
- Customise what happens when you click on a Wizard PDF, either open in your browser as currently, or download the file to your computer.
- We have organised all the information on how to use the reports and information we provide, plus guides on using the web site into one place, the Wizard Library.
- When you create or modify a system, you can select the "Run" option to have your system run against the previous two years' worth of results to see its strike rate. You can also view the actual selected horses for the last 3 months. A quick link to the results of your systems is shown on the front page.

## New Product – Wizard Plus

Wizard Plus is a significant enhancement to the original Wizard formguide. For starters, Wizard Plus includes everything in the current Wizard formguide but adds a range of incredibly valuable new features.

### Wizard Race Fields

Once you purchase Wizard Plus for a day the Wizard Race Fields is enhanced to become Wizard Online. This enhanced facility continues to give you access via your browser to all information contained in the basic Wizard formguide.

However, Wizard Plus, being online includes other very valuable race analysis and information tools.

You can, for example with Wizard Plus...

- Add your own notes to races and runners.
- Access enhanced Stewards' reports, including jockey and trainer post race reports
- View the Performance quick view – at a glance see how well horses score on 7 key factors
- Also you can access the previous notes you wrote in a horses form and flag horses that have been selected by one or more of your systems.

- The Wizard Plus panel – this information rich panel shows the best rated runners from 4 key handicapping options, highlights any currently ‘out-performing’ jockey/trainer combinations, shows the horses most favoured by the race conditions after an analysis of the positive and negative factors each horse will face in the race, shows Wizard assessed odds, and also provides running style details for each horse

### Wizard Plus Performance Charts

They chart the performance of companies, don't they. Why not chart the performance of race horses? Why not, indeed! With Wizard Plus you can now access detailed performance charts for every runner engaged on a day.

The Wizard Horse Performance Charts provide a visual presentation of a horse's form cycle and is rich with information. You can even elect to see the horse's ratings history using weight for age adjusted ratings rather than time specific base ratings ... a great way to see if a horse has the potential to improve on its current ratings.

Colour coding highlights a win/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> placing, dry and wet tracks, metro and non-metro location, and makes it quick and easy to see for each start which run was it from a spell and how many days since its last start. But that is just the beginning.

Hover over a race start and a pop up window appears which provides you with details about that past run ... track, date, going, distance, class, group status, finish position, number of starters, margin, time, weight, barrier, in-running positions, odds fluctuations, winner/second name, jockey, trainer, base rating, weight for age adjusted rating, Steward/jockey/trainer after race reports.

Analysing the race history of a horse has never been easier.

### More reports – including Wizard Essentials

A number of new PDF reports are included in Wizard Plus.

Along with the Ratings Plus and Proform reports, Wizard Plus now makes available the ultimate one-liner report on each runner in its new **Wizard Plus Essentials** report.

Wizard Essentials makes it easier than ever to compare the relative strengths and weaknesses of each of the runners in a race, and it does so by jampacking a horse's single data line with essential key information.

For each horse the following is provided on its data line:

- Wizard filter rating and ranking
- Horse name
- Negative factors rating
- Age and sex
- Form figures
- Runs from spell
- Wizard's pre-post market (set to 120%)
- Wizard weight rating (Wrat)m and ranking
- Wizard model rating (Wmod) and ranking

- Wizard relative weight analysis rating (Whcp) and ranking
- Wizard Expected Peak analysis rating (WExPk) and ranking
- Expected Peak ratings details ... date of past run, current or last prep, number of starts since that run
- Career win percentage
- Wins, places, starts in last 12 months
- TCDW ... track, class, distance, wet track legend
- Jockey name
- Jockey record on the horse
- Trainer
- Jockey record on race favourite in past 12 months
- Trainer record with race favourite in past 12 months
- Jockey/trainer combination record with race favourite in past 12 months
- Barrier position

- Course and distance stats

Laid out in easy-to-read tabular format the Wizard Plus Essentials report makes horse comparison easier than ever before.

### Wizard Watch

As well as providing Wizard Plus users with an unrivalled insight into the ratings and form history details of every runner, Wizard Plus also provides a unique insight into the most significant betting market moves each race morning via a Wizard Watch Morning Movers report which is made available around 11am each race day.

Analysing the morning price changes and betting volume trends over the first 3 hours of race day betting provides a special insight into those horses that are 'expected' to run above earlier expectations.

Wizard has developed algorithms that identify those horses that are likely to exceed early expectations and through Wizard Watch Morning Movers makes this information available exclusively to Wizard Plus users. This information can be used in conjunction with traditional ratings analysis, or those horses identified as the significant Morning Movers can be supported on their own merits.

Supplementing traditional form analysis with the Morning Movers price/volume race morning action has the potential to significantly improve the accuracy of race assessment.

### Stats and Facts

Extensive information on many form factors is included in very detailed reports found under the Stats and Facts option in Wizard Plus.

- Jockey Challenge analysis and past Jockey Challenge results.

- Detailed Wizard panel rankings.
- Wizard Speed Map shows likely in-running positions on settling and near home turn.
- Barrier Stats for each race and key supplementary data.
- Horse stats – career, track, distance, track and distance with links to full race data.
- Horse stats – Group race record – Group1, Group2, Group3, Listed, all Groups.
- Horse stats – the going record for each horse – firm, good, soft, heavy, all weather.
- Horse stats – form cycle – first-up, second-up, third-up, fourth-up, with links to form details.
- Jockey stats – for each rider for last 12 months – all rides, when =< 10/1, on race favourite.
- Jockey stats – details at the track, in the distance range, on firm/good, on soft/heavy.
- Jockey stats – record of each jockey in Group races, linked to race details.
- Jockey stats – with the trainer, on the horse, at similar tracks (location), in Group 1 races.
- Trainer stats – location, wins, starters, win percentage, average winning distance.
- Trainer stats – at the track, in the distance range, on firm/good, on soft/heavy.
- Trainer stats – Group race record – Group1, Group2, Group3, Listed, all groups.
- Trainer stats – with the jockey, on similar racetracks (location), in Group 1 races.
- Trainer stats – age record – with 2yo runners, with 3yo, with horses 4yo and older.
- Trainer stats – form cycle – first-up runners, 2-up, 3-up, 4-up, 5-up, 6+-up.
- Sire stats – for the sire of each runner – overall progeny record, distance, track, location.
- Sire stats – by age – good going, wet tracks, with trainer, in Group races.
- Sire stats – record of progeny by age in Group1, Group2, Group3, and Listed races.
- Sire stats – related to individual runners.

This information in these reports can be enhanced by linking to the relevant race details, sorting individual columns, etc.

To make it much easier for you to find the information you want to access on a regular basis Wizard Plus allows you to create custom reports, picking just the information you want from over a thousand different facts we provide.
